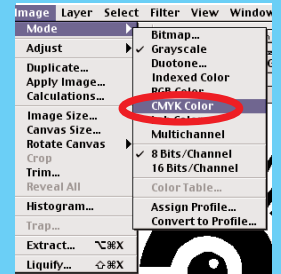
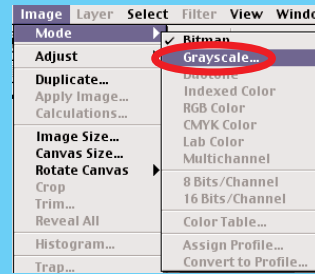
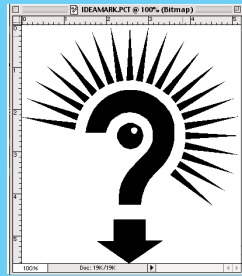
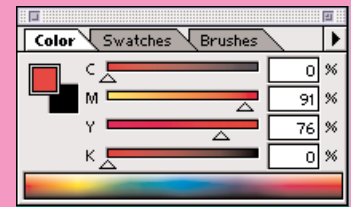
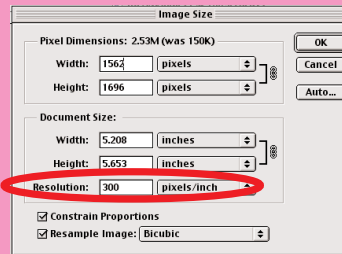
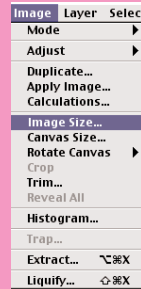


Step by Step Walk Through For Creative Colour Photoshop

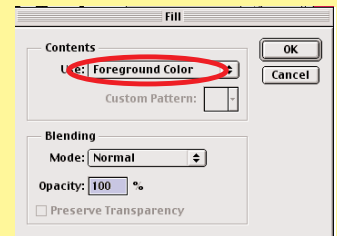
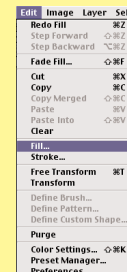
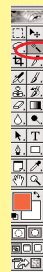
1. Open document.
2. If image is bitmap make image grayscale.
3. Make image CMYK.



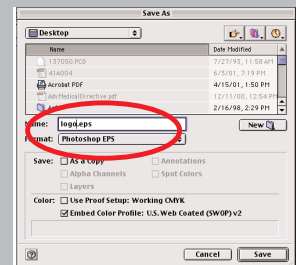
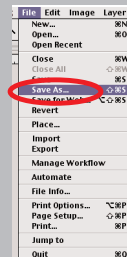
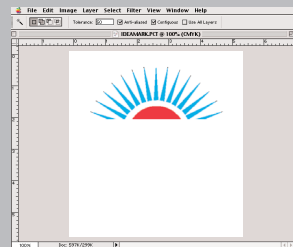
1. Make sure image is 300 dpi.*¹
 2. Mix colour in colour pallet as per Creative Colour chart.
- Example here is for colour #11.



1. Select magic wand from tool bar.
2. With magic wand click on each section that you want to colour while holding down the shift key.
3. Fill the selection with the foreground colour.



1. Repeat process for each colour.
2. Make sure that all areas are correctly coloured.
3. Save file as an eps.



Things to note:

- When scanning in your image you must scan it at 300 dpi.
- *¹- Adding resolution in Photoshop does not increase the quality.
- There are many other ways to make selections. Feel free to use the one that works the best for you.
- Only the colour mixes on the Creative Colour Chart can be used under the Creative Colour program.
