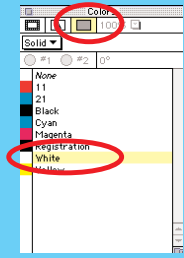
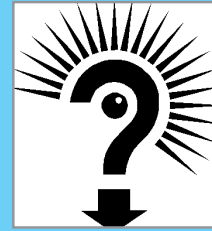
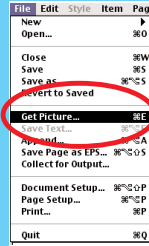


# Step by Step Walk Through For Creative Colour QuarkXPress

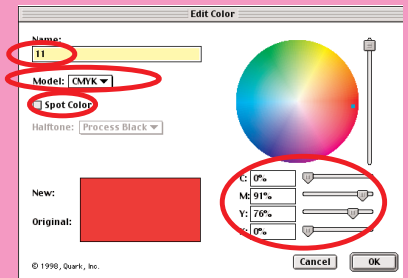
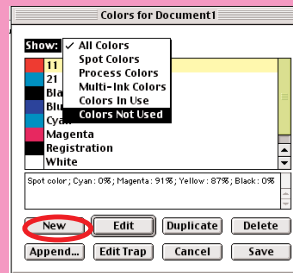
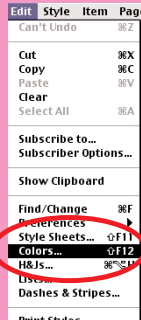
1. Place bitmap or tiff file.

Note: If placing a tiff file, background of picture box must be coloured white. Bitmap images can have a fill of none.



1. Mix colour in colour pallet as per Creative Colour chart.  
2. Name the colour with the correct Creative Colour number.

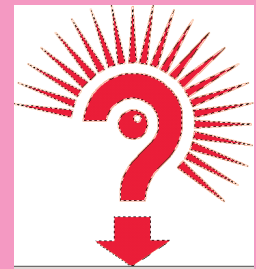
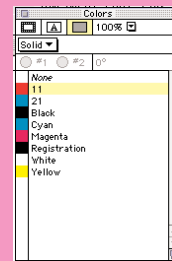
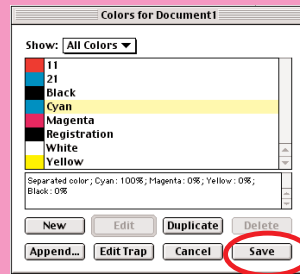
Note : Always make sure that CMYK is selected and that the Spot colour box is not checked off.



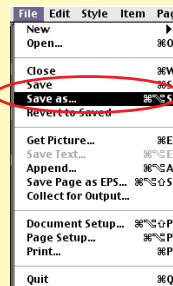
Example here is for colour #11.

Note: Before you send us your file, use the "colours not used" to remove all colours not used in your document.

Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Black cannot be deleted.



1. Save file.



## Things to note:

- Only the colour mixes on the Creative Colour Chart can be used under the Creative Colour program.
- You will not be able to colour the object more than 1 colour. If graphic is more than one colour then it must be coloured in Illustrator, FreeHand, Photoshop or CorelDRAW.
